- JOB DESCRIPTION:** This is an exempt, full-time 187 day position. The School Counselor will be responsible for identifying counseling needs and providing individual and group counseling to deaf and hard-of-hearing students. Other services include: providing outreach services to parents and families, developing/coordinating behavior management programs in the classroom/residential setting, providing crisis counseling with students, assisting high school students with post high school planning, preparing and maintaining records on students and addressing concerns to appropriate personnel and other related duties.
- MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** To be considered, individuals must possess a minimum of a Master's degree in school counseling or psychology and possess or be eligible for PA Department of Education Certification in Elementary/Secondary School Counselor or Psychologist.
- Sign language skills of applicants will be rated using the Sign Language Proficiency Interview (SLPI); "Advanced" level skills are preferred at hire.
- PA Act 34 Criminal Background, Child Abuse, and FBI clearances required.
