### **MINIMUM**

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Completion of an educational program which includes a Master's degree plus additional course work and an internship in school psychology. PA Certification in School Psychology K-12 required.

Sign language skills of applicants will be rated using the Sign Language Proficiency Interview (SLPI); "Advanced" level skills are preferred at hire.

PA Criminal Background clearance, PA Child Abuse clearance, and FBI clearance required.
