POSITION TITLE: Speech Language Teacher / Outreach Support

REPORTS TO: Principal

LOCATION: Scranton School for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Children, Clarks Summit, PA

JOB DESCRIPTION: This is an exempt, full-time 187 day position. The Speech Teacher/Outreach Support person will work with children to provide the necessary support services to enhance the students' spoken English capabilities. The teacher provides instruction in speech production, speech reading, auditory training, and the use (pragmatics) of spoken English. This position is responsible for working with classroom teachers and supervisors to provide a supportive program for students which meets their communication needs. This position also provides outreach support as needed to school districts, Intermediate Units, students, and their families. This person will also work with professionals outside of SSDHHC to provide in-service programs and workshops. This person will serve on the Outreach Team for SSDHHC, WPSD, and Camp Hill.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Master's Degree with PA certifications in Speech & Language Impaired and Hearing Impaired. Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC), and experience working with deaf and hard-of-hearing children is required. The individual must be energetic, creative, and have a positive, encouraging style of teaching.

Sign Language skills of applicants will be rated using the SLPI; "Advanced" skills are preferred at hire.

PA Criminal Clearance, PA Child Abuse Clearance and FBI Clearance are required.

SALARY: Dependent on degree and experience, with full benefits including membership in the State's teacher retirement system, medical, dental, vision, and life insurance.
