POSITION TITLE: Long-Term Substitute Speech-Language Pathologist

REPORTS TO: Principal

LOCATION: Western Pennsylvania School for the Deaf, Pittsburgh, PA

DURATION: Immediately through the end of January 2019.

JOB DESCRIPTION: This is a long-term substitute position. The Speech Teacher will work with children to provide the necessary support services to enhance the students' spoken English capabilities. The teacher provides instruction in speech production, speech reading, auditory training, and the use (pragmatics) of spoken English. This position is responsible for working with classroom teachers and supervisors to provide a supportive program for students which meets their communication needs.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's Degree with PA Dept of Education Certification in Speech and Language Impaired, and Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC) is required. Master's Degree with PDE certification in Speech and Language Impaired, dual certification in Hearing Impaired preferred. Experience working with deaf and hard of hearing children is also preferred.

This position will be rated using Sign Language Proficiency Interview (SLPI). The level for this position is "Advanced." The minimum level accepted at hire is "Novice Plus."

PA Criminal Background, PA Child Abuse, and FBI Clearance required.

Valid PA Driver's License required.
