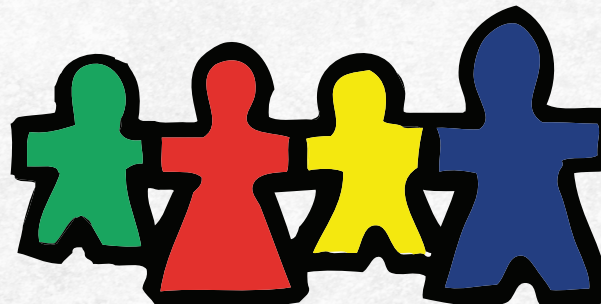

ABOUT THE CHILDREN'S CENTER

The Children's Center follows the Creative Curriculum which promotes learning in a structured environment through circle time activities and meaningful, hands-on play. Our curriculum is aligned with Pennsylvania Early Learning Standards. It is a year-round program with scheduled breaks in June and August.

A small class size allows for individualized, student-centered instruction in a child friendly classroom. Modular learning and study based materials promote learning through play and support the development of vocabulary and language.
