JOB DESCRIPTION:

This is a full-time, exempt, 199 day position. Responsibilities include:

- Develops and manages an audiological program addressing student needs and coordinates services, evaluates
 effectiveness, oversees equipment and facilities, collaborates with staff and prepares financial reports and
 orients new speech-language personnel.
- Supervises professionals, interns, (undergraduate and graduate), and clerical staff
- Schedules evaluations, administers diagnostic tests based on individual student needs, communicates
 effectively with student, families, and staff, gathers additional records, and provides diagnostic conclusions and
 recommendations
- · Leads and participates in community presentations to build and maintain educational and business partnerships
- Supports recruitment and placement of students for the Choices of Children early intervention and school-age programs
- Conducts age-appropriate audiological testing for children (birth to 22) with hearing loss ranging from normal to profound
- Assesses needs and fits group or individual amplification, selects appropriate technology, and evaluates its
 effectiveness

QUALIFICATIONS:

Doctor of Audiology and licensure from the PA Department of State Board of Examiners in Audiology

SIGNING REQUIREMENTS:
